## SCHEDULE

**Registration deadline: Wed., April 18**TH Reservations will be made on first come first serve basis. Sign up early!!

Participants will receive workshop confirmations and directions to Camp WYOMOCO by Tuesday, April 24TH. Individual workshop fees will be due by Wednesday, May 2ND.

- Workshops are divided into the following age groups: (YOUTH: CLOVERBUDS), (YOUTH: AGES 8-14) & (ADULT: AGES 14-ADULT) Note: Some workshops may accommodate all age groups
- Program registration is \$2.00 per person (checks are payable to CCE of Wyoming County), which includes morning refreshments, facility fees, and miscellaneous supplies. Note: The \$2.00 fee is non-refundable unless the entire event must be cancelled due to low enrollment.
- Registration: Please provide as many choices as possible (5 for each session). Workshops may be closed due to a class size limitations, a cancellation, or the order in which your registration was received. It is extremely helpful when scheduling to be provided with as many choices of interest. If choices are not given and a class is closed, we reserve the right to sign you up for any available class.
- Most workshops require an ADDITIONAL COST. This helps cover workshop supplies and other expenses the instructor incurs in teaching the workshop. This additional cost must be paid when you receive your class workshop confirmation and schedule. If no cost is listed for a workshop, there is no additional cost.
- Classes will be assigned and a confirmation letter mailed to participants on <u>Tuesday, April 24TH</u>. After receiving your class assignments, you will need to send the additional class fee by Wednesday, May 2ND to the Wyoming County 4-H Office. On Monday, May 7TH, letters will be sent to instructors with their confirmed class list(s).
- Those not sending the workshop fees will be dropped from classes; fees must be paid in advance! Class assignments will also be available on our website (http://wyoming.cce.cornell.edu/fun-day) the week of April 23RD. It is your responsibility to check your assignments and send in your instructor fees by Wednesday, May 2ND!
- Instructors are given a class count, and prepare for that. Please do not expect to get into a class on the day of the event.
- Plan to send your registration form and fee directly to the Wyoming County 4-H office.
- Please plan to dress appropriately for inclement weather, as many of these workshops will be taking place outside. Proper footwear will also be necessary as various buildings and facilities throughout camp will be used for these workshops.
- Registration is not valid without accompanying payment of \$2 per person.
