Plant Variety Descriptions

Tomato Varieties – Blight Resistant



Cherry Bomb – Late blight-resistant field cherry. Cherry Bomb is perfect for the organic grower who needs strong late blight protection. Vigorous plants produce high yields of uniform, vivid red fruits with ideal cherry size (15-20 gm.) for harvest and snacking. Classic cherry tomato flavor - firm, sweet, and well-balanced. Unique calyx makes an attractive display when left attached to fruit. High resistance to late blight. Indeterminate.

Juliet Grape – Great flavor, fresh or cooked. A larger sister variety of Santa, Juliet is one of the most disease resistant in our trials. Deep red, shiny fruits avg. 2–2 1/4" x 1 3/8–1 1/2", weighing 1 1/2–2 oz. Typically 12–18 fruits per cluster. Delicious, rich tomato flavor for salads, great salsa, and fresh pasta sauce. Good crack resistance, vine storage, and shelf life. AAS Winner. Indeterminate.



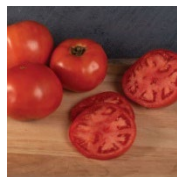
Defiant - Bred for earliness, disease resistance, and flavor. This mid-size slicer has high resistance to late blight and intermediate resistance to early blight combined with great flavor. The 6-8 oz., globe-shaped fruit are smooth and medium-firm with good texture. Deep red internal and external color. High-yielding, medium-sized plants are widely adaptable. Defiant was traditionally bred to inherit the Ph-2 and Ph-3 major genes for late blight.

Mountain Merit – Late blight-resistant slicer. Mountain Merit is an 8-10 oz., red slicer with an excellent disease package. Larger than Defiant PhR, though the flavor is not quite as good. Mountain Merit's disease package is well suited to all temperate regions, extending into the South. High resistance to Fusarium wilt races 1, 2, and 3, late blight, nematodes, tomato spotted wilt virus, and Verticillium wilt. Determinate.



Plum Regal – A productive plum tomato with late blight resistance. Medium-size plants with good leaf cover produce high yields of blocky, 4 oz. plum tomatoes. Fruits have a deep red color with good flavor. Good disease resistance package. High resistance to fusarium wilt races 1, 2, late blight, tomato spotted wilt virus, and verticillium wilt, and intermediate resistance to early blight. Determinate.

Damsel - Late blight resistance and excellent flavor. Damsel produces avg. 8-12 oz., globe-shaped fruits with beautiful, pink skin. Shares flavor qualities (sweet, rich, and tangy) with traditional pink heirlooms, such as Brandywine and Pruden's Purple, but is more resistant to disease. Compact indeterminate plants require minimal pruning.



Galahad- Delicious early determinate beefsteak - Galahad beats industry comparisons with its fantastic flavor and impressive disease resistance profile, which extends much-needed protection to regions ranging from the Midwest to the Deep South. Excellent late blight resistance and early maturity also make Galahad a strong contender in the North. The round, 7–12 oz. fruits can be harvested with green shoulders and ripened red in storage or ripened on the vine.

Vegetable Varieties

Hot Portugal Chile peppers are elongated, curved to straight pods, averaging 12 to 20 centimeters in length, and have a conical shape that tapers to a point on the non-stem end. The pods may appear very twisted and curved, and the skin is wrinkled or smooth, waxy, and glossy, ripening from green to dark red when mature. Underneath the surface, the flesh is thin, crisp, and aqueous, encasing a central cavity filled with many round and flat, cream-colored seeds. Hot Portugal Chile peppers have a subtle, sweet flavor mixed with a moderate to hot level of spice that lingers on the palate.



Jalapeno peppers (moderately hot) - Smooth, dark green fruits. Vigorous plants consistently produce very high yields of 3 1/2 to 4" fruits that are resistant to cracking.

Sweet Bell (*Early red, sweet*) - A standard early variety for years. It's one of the earliest peppers to mature and has been a consistent producer of good yields, even when others have not set fruit because of hot weather. It's a 3 to 4 lobed fruit that has medium thick walls and is sweet and tender.



Sweet Banana - This hybrid pepper has been a consistent performer in the Northeast. The rich green fruit that ripens red has a uniform deep bell shape with 3-4 lobes and medium-thick walls. Lady Bell is prolific, even in cooler weather, and is one of the dependable producers of sweet peppers we know.

6 Pack - Bush Beans – Green or Yellow bush type bean plants with long straight beans.

4 Pack - Cabbage – Available in a standard green (early) variety.

4 Pack of vegetables – Varieties include: Broccoli, Cauliflower, Eggplant and Leaf Lettuce Mix.

4 packs of vegetables – Varieties include:

- Cucumbers: Slicing or Pickling
- Summer Squash: Zucchini or Yellow Summer Squash
- Winter Squash: Acorn Squash or Butternut Squash.

Perennial Herbs 3" pot – Available in Lavender, Rosemary, Thyme, Sage, or Italian Oregano.

Annual Herbs 4 pack – Available in Basil or Parsley.

6 packs of Flowers – Available in mixed color marigold, mix color Petunia or mix color Portulaca.

5" Flowerpots – Available in Pink, Red, White or Salmon Geraniums.
