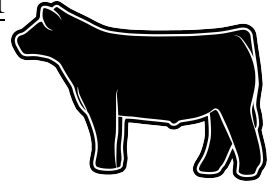

General Beef Guidelines

1. See health requirements in front of Fair book.
2. For safety, all beef need to be dehorned, unless they are part of the breeds characteristics. Call 4-H Dept. for details.
3. Exhibitors are limited to a maximum of 4 beef animals (including meat animal projects) per exhibitor, with no more than 2 entries allowed per class. Exhibitors must show their own animals unless they have 2 per class or are excused by the superintendent.
4. Heifers shown in breeding classes can't be shown in feeder classes and feeders can't be shown in breed classes.
5. In cow and calf class, both animals have to be owned by same exhibitor. The calf can also be shown in an individual class. Calf must still be nursing at side. Judge may ask for calf to nurse cow in the ring.
6. Each exhibitor must show in appropriate showmanship class. Each contestant must show his or her own animal, but may be asked during the contest to show another animal.
7. British Breeds: Angus, Shorthorn, and Hereford, or crosses between these breeds.
8. Continental Breeds: Charolais, Simmental, Limousin, and all cattle with a percentage of these breeds. This group also includes beef bred cattle with a percentage of dairy blood in them.
9. Dairy Breed Steers & Feeders: all breeds bred specifically for milk production, such as Holstein or Brown Swiss or crosses between these breeds.

General Beef Premiums

Guarantee: \$8.50 per animal in calf & heifer classes. \$10.50 per animal in finished steer & two-year old and over cattle.

Showmanship Class Premiums: 1st - \$10.00; 2nd - \$7.00; 3rd - \$5.00; 4th - \$3.00; 5th - \$2.00

Points for classes 101 thru 310: 1st blue – 6 points; blue – 5 points; red – 2 points

Livestock Herdsmanship Awards

All beef cattle, sheep, and swine will be stabled by clubs within their species areas. Livestock exhibitors who maintain attractive and sanitary exhibits will be eligible for species specific herdsman awards in addition to overall livestock herdsman awards. Daily inspections to be made unannounced, after 10 a.m. (Sun., Mon., Tues., Wed.) All clubs, families, and individual members will be judged together. Ties will be broken on cleanliness of animals. Awards for each species: 1st - \$20; 2nd - \$15; 3rd - \$10; 4th - \$5; 5th - \$5.

BEEF DIVISION - MEAT ANIMAL PROJECT CLASS SHOW - MONDAY, AUGUST 17, 2026

Locust Lane Limousin of Perry, will award a trophy to the Beef Bred Meat Animal Project Champion. Sharon True and Karen Duboy of Warsaw, will award a trophy to the Dairy Beef Meat Animal Project Champion. Reserve Champion Beef Bred Project award sponsored by Townline Limousin, Arcade. Reserve Champion Dairy Bred Project awards sponsored by Broughton Cattle Company, Silver Springs.

1. Cattle must have been entered in the Meat Animal Program by December 6th for this class. Please refer to Meat Animal Guidelines available from the 4-H office for this project.
2. Beef and Dairy Beef meat animal projects must weigh between a minimum of 1,000 pounds and maximum of 1,600 pounds at the final weighing on August 15th to be eligible for the meat animal show and sale.

- 500 Beef Bred Meat Animal Showmanship – Senior (14 and over).
- 501 Dairy Bred Meat Animal Showmanship – Senior (14 and over).
- 502 Beef Bred Meat Animal Showmanship – Junior (13 and under).
- 503 Dairy Bred Meat Animal Showmanship – Junior (13 and under).
- 504 Beef Bred Meat Animal Project (classes will be divided by weight of animal).
- 505 Dairy Bred Meat Animal Project (classes will be divided by weight of animal).
