Those not registered will **not** have an opportunity to pick up items.
- We ask that people only take what they can truly use. Please reach out to the 4-H office with any questions or to register for a time slot to view and pick up items. Again, they will be available that day on a <u>first come first serve basis, by appointment</u>.
