An evaluation is to measure the safety and riding level of 4-H members. Evaluations will take place on the following days:

- Thursday June 6th 6pm, Kingbrook Farms – Chaffee
- Thursday June 20th 6pm, Diana Henry's – Bliss
- Tuesday June 25th 6pm, The Meadows – Marilla
