Showmanship Classes

- S1 Senior Showmanship, youth 14 years & older as of Jan. 1.
 S2 Junior Showmanship, youth 13 years & under as of Jan. 1.
 S3 Novice Showmanship, youth exhibiting sheep for the first time.
 S4 Super Showmanship, open to current trophy winners in classes S1, S2 and S3.

Halter Showmanship Classes (optional class, may use any type of halter)

- S5 Senior Halter Class, youth 14 years & older as of Jan. 1.
 S6 Junior Halter Class, youth 13 years & under as of Jan. 1.
 S7 Champion Halter Showman, open to current year winners of classes S5 & S6.

Team Showmanship (optional class with two exhibitors showing an animal. The sheep must be owned and fitted by at least one of the exhibitors.)

- S8 Junior Team, both team members are 13 & under as of Jan. 1.
 S9 Senior Team, one or both team members are at least 14 years & older as of Jan. 1.

Sheep Individual Classes – Registered & Grades

- All registered animals must be accompanied by papers. All registered classes will be sectioned into breed divisions.
- Mature ewe born before Sept. 1, 2024 and must have lambed after Sept. 1, 2025
- Yearling ewe born before Sept. 1, 2025 and after Sept. 1, 2024
- Lambs born on or after Sept. 1, 2025
- Jr. Flock, 1 ram lamb and 2 ewes of any age. A grade flock must have a registered ram lamb. Only 1 flock per exhibitor can be entered in the youth show.

S100 Market lamb (wether or ewe lambs) born on or after Jan. 1, 2026 - Lambs will be weighed and classes will be divided by weight.

S101 Pen of 2 market lambs (wether or ewe lambs) born after Jan. 1, 2026 - Ewe lamb shown in breed class may be one of pen of two.

Fleece Classes

Fleeced should be entered at the youth building on Friday, August 14th from 1pm - 7pm. Dry Fleeces should be skirted and presented in clear plastic bag.

Points: first blue 3 ½ points; blue 2 ½ points; red 1 point

S104 Long Wool (48's and coarser – 31 microns)

S103 Medium Wool (50's thru 62's – 22-30 micron)

Livestock Herdsmanship Awards

All beef cattle, sheep, and swine will be stabled by clubs within their species areas. Livestock exhibitors who maintain attractive and sanitary exhibits will be eligible for species specific herdsman awards in addition to overall livestock herdsman honors. Daily inspections to be made unannounced, after 10a.m. (Sun., Mon., Tues., Wed.) All clubs, families, and individual members will be judged together. Ties will be broken on cleanliness of animals. Awards for each species: 1st - \$20; 2nd - \$15; 3rd - \$10; 4th - \$5; 5th - \$5.

LAMB DIVISION - MEAT ANIMAL PROJECT CLASS - SHOW - MONDAY, AUGUST 17, 2026

Empire Livestock Marketing Coop., Inc. will present a trophy to the Grand Champion Meat Animal Project Lamb.

Reserve Champion project sponsored by the Swartz Family, Attica.

1. Lambs must have been entered in the Meat Animal Program by May 7th for this class. Please refer to Meat Animal Guidelines available from the 4-H office for this project.

2. Meat animal project lambs must weigh between a minimum of 90 pounds and maximum of 145 pounds at the final weighing on August 15th to be eligible for the meat animal show and sale.
