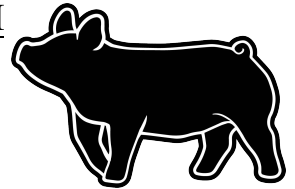

General Swine Guidelines

1. See health requirements in the front of the Fair book.
2. All hogs must have individual identification approved by NYS Ag & Markets. Each animal must be so identified on the health certificate.
3. Two entries may be made by each exhibitor for the 4-H show held on Friday.
4. Gilts shown in the breeding classes cannot be entered as a market hog.
5. The Dept. H superintendent can limit the number of entries accepted per exhibitor if stall space becomes a problem.
6. Each exhibitor must participate in a showmanship class. Each contestant must show his or her own animal, but may be asked during the contest to show another animal.

General Swine Premiums

Guarantee: \$4.50 per animal

Showmanship Premiums: 1st - \$5.00; 2nd - \$4.00; 3rd - \$3.00; 4th - \$2.00; 5th - \$1.00.

Points for classes H10 – H14: first blue 3 ½ points; blue 2 ½ points; red 1 point

- H800 Market Hog (all breeds born on or after January 1, 2026. Recommended minimum of 150lbs. Hogs will be divided into weight classes.)
- H107 White Breed January Gilt born Jan 2026
- H108 White Breed Senior Spring Gilt born Feb 2026
- H109 White Breed Junior spring Gilt born March 1, 2026 or later
- H207 Colored Breed January Gilt born Jan 2026
- H208 Colored Breed Senior Spring Gilt born Feb 2026
- H209 Colored Breed Junior spring Gilt born March 1, 2026 or later
- H305 All Breeds Jr. Yearling Sow farrowed litter Jan 1- June 30, 2026
- H306 All Breeds Fall Sow farrowed litter July 1 - Dec 31, 2026

Livestock Herdsmanship Awards: All beef cattle, sheep, and swine will be stabled by clubs within their species areas. Livestock exhibitors who maintain attractive and sanitary exhibits will be eligible for species specific herdsmanhip awards in addition to overall livestock herdsmanhip honors. Daily inspections to be made unannounced, after 10 AM (Sun., Mon., Tues., Wed.). All clubs, families and individual members will be judged together. Ties will be broken on cleanliness of animals. Awards for each species: 1st - \$20; 2nd - \$15; 3rd - \$10; 4th - \$5; 5th - \$5.

**SWINE DIVISION - MEAT ANIMAL PROJECT CLASS
SHOW - SATURDAY, AUGUST 15, 2026**

John and Gloria Stenson, Warsaw, will present a trophy to the Grand Champion meat animal project hog exhibitor. Reserve Champion project award sponsored by the Weixlmann Family, Arcade.

1. Hogs must have been entered in the Meat Animal Program for this class.
2. Meat animal project hogs must weigh between a minimum of 225 pounds and a maximum of 300 pounds at the final weighing on August 14th to be eligible for the meat animal show and sale.

Classes

- H20 Meat Animal Showmanship - classes will be divided by age of exhibitors
- H21 Meat Animal Market Hog - classes will be divided by weight of animals
